

The Mesa County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship

MCCA Mission: To advocate for causes affecting the local cattle industry and to educate and involve youth in agriculture.

This scholarship recognizes and encourages talented students who will one day be industry leaders. Students studying education, communication, production, research or other areas related to the beef industry should consider applying for the scholarship.

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or full-time undergraduate student enrolled at a two or four-year college with a GPA of 2.5 or better.
2. Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation, 1 from a current MCCA or CCA Member
3. Applicant must submit application, the most recent high school or college transcript to the MCCA Board for proof of grade point average and enrollment. Selected applicants may also be asked to write an essay.
4. Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential throughout extracurricular activities and work experiences.
5. Applicant must be a member of the Mesa County Cattlemen's Association, or have an immediate relative that is a member.
6. To redeem scholarship, applicant must provide MCCA proof of college enrollment. Funds for scholarship will be sent directly to the recipients institutions. In the event a recipient does not use all of the funding, the remaining portion will be returned to the MCCA.
7. Applications must be turned into the MCCA and postmarked by January 1, 2017 to be considered.

10. Applicants may apply for the application once more if they have already received it.
